

Inventoria™ is an easy-to-use application for managing assets. Tight integration with FirstClass makes Inventoria simple to deploy and manage, leveraging existing infrastructure and requiring no specialized software or training for staff.

Inventoria may be deployed in stand-alone mode for asset tracking only, or combined with Ticketus, a comprehensive work order tracking solution for FirstClass. When combined with Ticketus, work orders created on each asset may be analyzed based on asset types, manufacturers, and models to examine reliability and total cost for purchases.

Benefits

Know what you have: Locate and account for equipment across your organization, including item locations and quantities.

Reduce workloads: Distribute responsibility for maintenance of inventory records, securely assigning designated staff to manage inventory by location.

Maintain compliance: Manage and track support contracts, warranty dates, software license limits, and software allocation across your enterprise.

Features For Location Managers

Inventoria allows designation of specific staff who manage assets within a given location. These Location Managers are empowered to track, update, and report on all assets under their domain. Features available to location managers include:

Create new assets and assign them to rooms in your building.

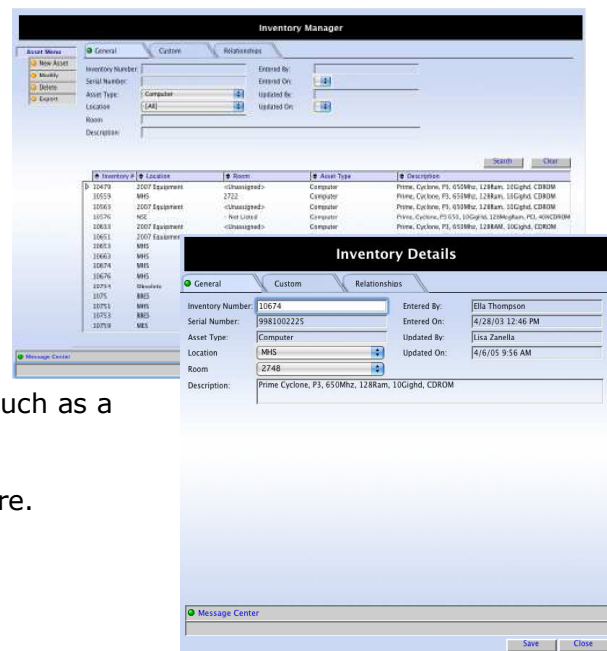
Duplicate existing assets, allowing rapid input of multiple items of similar make or model.

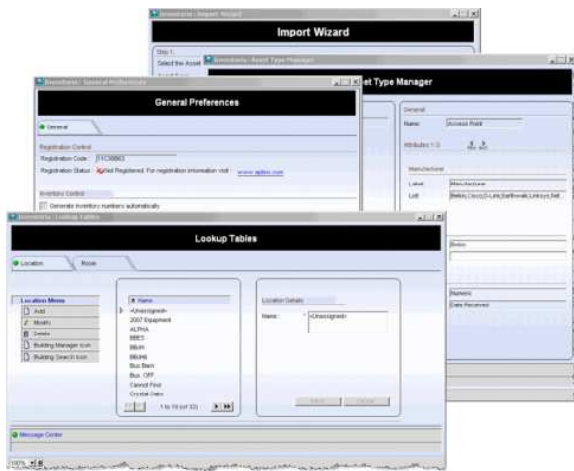
